## Weight

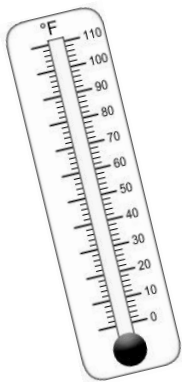
Students compare and predict the weight of objects in grams and ounces using rocker balances.

## Capacity

Students will estimate and measure everyday items to become more familiar with ounces, cups, pints, quarts, and gallons.

## Length, Width, and Temperature

Students measure length and width using standard and non-standard methods. They will also measure temperature in degrees Celsius.
